# Parichay

## Essay 1: Solution of problems: Pramukh Swami Maharaj.

### I. Section 1:

- A. Delhi Akshardham was made in just 5 years. It is a visible representation of Akshardham itself on this earth given to us by Pramukh Swami Maharaj himself. No one was as involved as Pramukh Swami Maharaj in the process of making Akshardham.
- B. There were many problems that were un-thought of, but because of Pramukh Swami Maharaj's blessings, the solution always became obvious. Anytime there were any issues, Swamishri remained calm and composed.

#### II. Section 2:

- A. Famous Indian architect, Shri B.V. Doshi came to look at Delhi Akshardham when it was still being constructed and he was very impressed. Santos told him to give some advice on the construction as he had designed the marketplaces of Venice and downtown of Austria. He replied that, "When a plant grows it grows naturally by itself, but looking at Akshardham it is obvious that this is the result of divine interaction. Do not ask any professional architect for advice because anything that they could recommend would only decrease the beauty of the structure."
- B. Bachubhai Sompura, architect of Houston and Chicago Swaminarayan mandirs, was crying and said "We try to make the marble carvings look just like the design but it never happens. This Pramukh Swami Maharaj was able to translate the exact design into the carvings. Because of this Pramukh Swami Maharaj is like God for me. If a normal person tried to do this, it would not be completed in 4 generations and Pramukh Swami Maharaj has finished it in 4 years."
- C. Furthermore, Brahmavihari Swami said "Any respected architect that comes here thinks that this structure (Akshardham) and only be the result of the divine blessing of a Satpurush."

## III. Section 3:

- A. Everyone was worried about how large of a portion of land it would require. Ishwarcharan Swami and Rithesh Ghadia surveyed the major structures of Dehli to see approximately how many people would come to Delhi Akshardham. Swamishri was sitting at Nitinbhai Ghadia's house discussing how many people would come to Akshardham. Swamishri said "This is a product of Yogiji Maharaj's wishes, so many people will come that you will be tired of counting."
- B. On the opening day of Akshardham, all the devotees thought that Pramukh Swami Maharaj would inaugurate it because it was created as a result of his guidance.Instead, Swamishri said that Akshardham would be inaugurated by the President, Prime Minister, and the leader of the opposing party. The inauguration occurred on November 6, 2005.

- C. President Kalam expressed his awe at the creation of Akshardham, saying that "Such a structure could not be made even with the help of hundreds of thousands of people in 5 years, and that it had to be the work of Swaminarayan Bhagwan residing and working through the atma of Pramukh Swami Maharaj." Swamishri replied that it is Bhagwan who works through all people.
- D. Heart Surgeon Dr. Subramanium asked Swamishri, "What is your next project after Akshardham?" Swamishri replied, "It is to spread satsang, prayer, and peace throughout the world."
- E. We will never have enough gratitude to thank Swamishri for giving us Akshardham on earth.
