#### Pravesh Essay 3:

## YuvaTalim Kendra: An Activity Inspired and Nourished by the Satpurush

#### I. Section 1:

- A. "What is in the Talim Kendra, which prepares such ideal youths in the short span of six months?" Such are the remarks that youths often hear from their family members, friends, and town folks after finishing their training at YuvaTalim Kendra. What is more unique about the evolution of the youths is that the amount of change in the youths is beyond imagination of the volunteers and sadhus involved in the training process.
- B. The reasoning behind initiating such a change is by inspiration of the GunatitSatpurush over the years. BrahmaswarupYogijiMaharaj laid a long-term vision for such training, which later came into fruition through the efforts of P.P. Pramukh Swami Maharaj.

#### II. Section 2:

A. October 28, 2008, P.P. Pramukh Swami was residing in Gondal. The yuvaks of the Talim Kendra presented speech and drama during Ravi Sabha assembly. During His ashirvad in the assembly later, Swamishri elaborated that 'Jogi Maharai desired and gave blessings to train the youths and as a result Yuvamandal and Kishore mandal were established. Everyone saw that the Satsang was flourishing, but to foster core values in tomorrow's generation coaching of youths was considered. Keeping this vision in mind, Talim Kendra in Sarangpur was established.'

#### III. Section 3:

A. The Talim Kendra that came into life through YogijiMaharaj's vision has grown tremendously under the guidance of ParamPujyaPramukh Swami Maharaj and

PujyaMahant Swami Maharaj. As a result, we have gained 1,200 yuvasevaks. PujyaMahant Swami Maharaj has explained the importance of Talim Kendra numerous times - 'The training that would take up to 60 years to nourish the youths, only takes 6 months here.' In a letter that he wrote from Sankri on June 1, 2011, He writes:

'This training is a privilege of this birth. All of you have taken birth many times, but have not once gotten such a training. A training that would teach you to overcome maya. In this world, many training centers exist, but the Talim Kendra in Sarangpur is the only one based on the gnan of Atma-Parmatma. More I think about it, more mahima I understand of the Talim Kendra.'

B. NayanPrajapati, A youth from Khambat, had gone for darshan and blessings of PujyaMahant Swami Maharaj on his birthday. He had just finished studying engineering, so he asked Swami "What should I do next?" Swami gave guidance for him to enroll in the Talim Kendra. Nayanbhai immediately agreed to it. Swami became very happy on hearing this and opened a candy from its wrapper and put it in Nayanbhai's mouth himself, tied a Nadachadion his hand, and gave three memorable pats on this back. Showering his blessings, He advised, 'Now go to the Talim Kendra promptly.' There are many youths like Nayanbhai, who were one on one inspired by Swamishri to join Talim Kendra.

#### IV. Section 4:

A. The bliss of GunatitSant has been felt by all partaking youths at the Talim Kendra in these past ten years both directly and indirectly. GunatitSant has put in personal efforts to get them enrolled in the training and to arrange for their needs while at the training. Moreover, during the training they have received motherly love, fatherly guidance, knowledge from a guru, and a bond of friendship through GunatitSatpurush. Pradeepbhai Pandya was fortunate to end his extreme fast at the hands of PramukhSwami Maharaj. Whereas Pradeepbhai Sharma had a similar opportunity at the hands of Mahant Swami Maharaj. Pramukh Swami Maharaj was advised to rest by doctors during his late years. However, He insisted on handing out the results of the trainings to the youths himself and blessed each youth individually

#### V. Section 5:

- A. Swamishri has played with these yuvaks and has fed them from time to time. To ensure the vision of the Talim Kendra is carried out, He has provided continuous guidance as well. 'We have well trained Sadhus. Now, to prepare well trained yuvaks, we have arranged for such training. If a yuvak migrates to foreign countries right now, he is able to drive satsang there via katha-varta due to such training. May all of you be motivated to do your best and inspire thousands to do satsang.'
- B. May 30, 2008, He inquired to the yuvaks sitting on the grounds of the SmrutiMandir how their training was coming along. He has even taken interest to keep them engaged in training and further development even after these yuvaks return back to their homes. June 6, 2009, Swamibapa was residing in Bochasan. P. Gnanvijay Swami, a sadhu heavily involved with the Talim Kendra teachings, was giving a report on a reunion of Talim Kendra Yuvaks from Tajetar area. Swamibapawould stop him from time to time during this session to gather more information. Then he asked, 'Do these yuvaks gather on regular basis after graduating from Talim Kendra?' To this P. Gnanvijay Swami replied, 'As per your guidance these yuvaks do gather in their areas once a month for goshti and at larger scale during reunions to keep their development ongoing.' Swamibapa was satisfied with the given answer provided and continued, 'That's great, these yuvaks gain lot of training in the six months they spend in Sarangpur, wherever they go they will perform equal to a sadhu.'

#### VI. Section 6:

A. Pramukh Swami Maharaj has created an army of fully talented youths. Bhagwan Swaminarayan came on this earth to make jivas attain the state of Brahmrup, so that they can attain ultimate salvation. Gunatit gurus have kept this sankalp of Bhagwan Swaminarayan at the center of guiding mile stones – such as the Talim Kendra. Pramukh Swami Maharaj has created this army of yuvasevaks keeping

ShreejiMaharaj's vision in mind. Once in Gondal, addressing the yuvaksSwamibapa said, 'All these yuvaks will in turn teach others and they will in turn teach others leading to unmeasurable progress. This was the reasoning behind Yogi Bapa'ssankalps.' These words of Pramukh Swami have come to life after ten years of establishment of YuvaTalim Kendra.

B. Swamibapa has provided unending guidance to the yuvaks of Talim Kendra, from time before their trainings to years after via phone, letter, or in person. Some yuvaks are such in who's life Swamibapa has been there from their smallest event to largest – job search, marriage, business to name few.
